Wire fraud continues to impact the real estate industry, now with direct attacks on homebuyers. Cyber criminals use spoofed email addresses and phone numbers to request that deposit money or funds needed for closing be sent to a different bank account.

If you receive a phone call, text message or email indicating that the wiring instructions have changed – **STOP**. Immediately contact someone using a trusted phone number (not the number in the message or on the caller ID) and verify those instructions before you wire funds.

Many criminals use a sense of urgency to trick victims into thinking the funds must be sent immediately. Don't send your money under pressure. Call us at the phone number on this brochure first.
